

5th Grade Summer Reading Project

Required Reading: *Amos Fortune: Freeman* by Elizabeth Yates

Required Project: Create a poster board to identify 5 main ideas from the book.

Project Guidelines:

1. Use your creativity to present important facts from the book, ***Amos Fortune: Freeman***.
2. The 5 main ideas should identify facts about Amos's life journey and character development as he goes from, a **Prince**, to a **Slave**, to a **Free Man**, to a **Respected Member of Society**, and finally to a **Christian**.
3. Use quotes and details from the book to adequately explain Amos's character through each stage of his journey and to support why you believe he became a Christian.
4. You will need to write at least 5 sentences for each trait, which should be typed. You will also need at least 1 picture per character trait that can be drawn or copied.

Some questions to use to guide your writing process:

- What examples are there to support him as: a prince, slave, free man, respected member & Christian?
- Why does he feel he is still a prince?
- What are the responsibilities for Amos that go along with being a free man and a Christian?
- How are Amos's thoughts, actions & attitude good examples for us to follow?
